



Communication with Parents

Effective communication is vital in building a strong partnership between teachers and parents/caregivers. At Creative Nest Early Center we use various modes of communication.

Roles and responsibilities of a teacher:

Creative nest early learning centre will be using the “parent app” as the main mode of communication.

- Post daily pictures along with a short message related to the learning of the day
- Post reminders of events, field trips and other activities including splash days.
- Newsletters to be shared on the app.
- Upload baseline and observations for each child.
- Learning journey/ILPs to be shared with parents by the end of the term if a child has attended at least 6-8 weeks.
- Encourage parents to communicate and check the app regularly.

Face to face meetings:

- Meet the teacher to be held for all children.
- Children progress to be shared with parents through “Child-led conference”
- ILPs or any concerns to be shared/discussed with parents.

Written Forms/Permission Slips:

- Where required, permission slips for internal/external events will be sent home.

Roles and responsibilities of parents.

- Parents to download and register on the parent app
- Parents to check the parent app regularly
- Communicate with teachers through the parent app
- Submit permission slips/written forms on the expected due date



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
